

 **RAILINC** | Rail Service Finder FAQs**What is Rail Service Finder (RSF)?**

Railinc maintains the Serving Carrier Reciprocal Switch (SCRS) system, which is a web application that provides a standardized verification process for determining whether and under what conditions a railroad may serve a specific customer at common service points. SCRS is a permissions-based data file used by railroads. RSF is a dedicated, streamlined version of the search feature within the SCRS industry reference file. Use this module to identify customer information and the rail carriers that serve them.

Why did Railinc change the name of the website to Rail Service Finder?

Railinc changed the name of the old Freight Rail 411 website to Rail Service Finder to more accurately reflect the website's use as a dedicated, streamlined version of the search feature within the SCRS industry reference file.

Who uses Rail Service Finder?

The primary customer stakeholders for the Rail Service Finder website are rail shippers and other freight-rail users.

Can I export data from Rail Service Finder?

No, export capabilities are not available through Rail Service Finder.
